A Meissen porcelain part service, 20th century, painted with scattered flower sprigs within gilt edged shaped rims, comprising a large oval platter, length 48cm, circular dish, diameter 30.5cm, square dish, length 23cm, eleven soup plates, diameter 23.5cm, twelve dinner plates, diameter 24.5cm, twelve dessert plates, diameter 19.5cm, two sauceboats and two oval platters, length 28cm, together with a matching dessert plate without gilt rim, underglaze blue crossed swords marks to bases and various impressed and painted marks to bases (minor faults).

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

Both sauceboats have small chips to the pouring lips and wear to the gilt rims.

Square bowl has wear to the gilt rim.

One soup plate is badly cracked.

One soup plate has a small starcrack to the well primarily visible to the underside.

One soup plate has a chip to the upper rim edge.

Otherwise the service is in good condition overall, with minor typical knife cuts and light wear.
