### LOT 1413

A matched set of six Flight, Barr & Barr Worcester botanical dessert plates, early 19th century, each painted with a central floral arrangement within gilt weed framing and a gilt gadrooned rim, various impressed and printed marks to bases, average diameter 22.8cm, a matching plate painted to the centre with two peasant figures, diameter 22cm, and a Barr, Flight & Barr Worcester square dish and single handled circular dish both later painted with a central butterfly against a gilt vermicular ground, impressed marks to bases. Provenance: The Flight Collection.

### Condition Report

6 botanical plates - 4 in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, 1 with the tiniest of nicks to underside rim edge which is not visible from the upper surface, and 1 with a small chip to the underside rim edge which is also not visible from the upper surface. Each with good strong gilding and enamels.

Peasant plate - 3 small chips to underside rim edge which are not visible from the upper surface, light wear and surface scratches.

Square dish - in good condition overall.

Circular dish - restoration to rim edge by handle and some wear to gilding overall.
