A Barr, Flight & Barr Worcester Japan pattern sauce tureen and cover, early 19th century, painted and gilt with flowers and foliage, flanked by gilt bird head and ring handles, the cover with flame finial, raised on a square base, impressed mark, height 17.5cm, together with a pair of Barr, Flight & Barr Worcester oval dishes, painted in iron red, pink and gilt with a chinoiserie Fence pattern, the gilt rims of shaped outline, impressed and puce printed marks, length 28.3cm (minor faults and restoration). Provenance: The Flight Collection. One of the oval dishes with Brian Haughton Antiques applied paper label.

Condition Report

Sauce tureen and cover - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, a couple of minuscule re-gilt nicks to finial of cover and possible re-gilding to one handle.

Dishes - both in good condition overall with no cracks or restoration, one with small chip to footrim, some incredibly minor and light surface scratches.
