A mixed group of Flight Barr Worcester tea and coffee cups and cans, early 19th century, including a pair of coffee cans and saucers with white and gilt leaves against an orange ground, four coffee cans and saucers gilt with a pseudo marbled pattern against an apricot ground beneath a gilt key fret rim, a pair of Etruscan shape teacups and saucers gilt with a band of foliate panels against a pale pink ground, a breakfast cup and saucer with cobalt blue and gilt leaves against an orange ground and a pair of cans and saucers gilt with a vermicular pattern, various impressed marks (minor faults). Provenance: The Flight Collection.

### Condition Report

2 ring handled cups with gilt vine against an orange ground - in good condition but with wear to gilding.

2 salmon ground angular handled cups with gilt foliate panelled decoration - one cup with minor restoration, otherwise all ok.

Saucer with gilt barley and blue leaves against an apricot ground - cracked.

Pair cans and saucers with gilt vermicular decoration - one can cracked, one saucer chipped.

4 cans and saucers with marbled pattern against apricot ground - varying degrees of wear to gilding of saucers, but otherwise ok.

Remaining items in the lot are generally in good condition overall with minor wear/surface scratches commensurate with age and handling, but no significant damage and no restoration.
