A set of four Flight, Barr & Barr Worcester teacups and saucers, early 19th century, each painted and gilt in a Japan pattern with a Chinese figure standing in a chinoiserie garden before a pavilion, within an iron red and gilt scrolling border and gilt gadrooned rim, some impressed marks, diameter of saucers 15.5cm, together with a small group of wares painted in the same pattern with plain gilt rims, comprising two trios and two extra teacups (minor faults). Provenance: The Flight Collection.

Condition Report

One gadrooned rim saucer cracked.

One plain edged saucer with minor restoration and chipping to rim edge.

Remaining items in the lot are in good condition overall with no damage or repairs but some typical light wear commensurate with age and handling.
