A mixed group of Flight & Barr Worcester cups and saucers, early 19th century, mostly with gadrooned rim, including three gilt overlaid orange ground teacups and saucers, three teacups and two saucers gilt with a seaweed pattern, two trios and two matching saucers gilt with a band of fruiting vine above a pink ground, a pink ground coffee cup and saucer gilt with a band of foliate scrollwork and a coffee cup and saucer with painted and gilt foliate decoration in iron red and pink, various impressed marks (some faults and repairs). Provenance: The Flight Collection.

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

Cup and saucer gilt with bellflowers against an apricot ground - saucer riveted, minor regilding to rim of cup.
Cup and 3 saucers with exotic birds and flowers against a gilt weed ground - all pieces extensively damaged and restored.

Pink banded cup and saucer with gilt scroll detail - saucer has small nicks to rim edge.

Trios with gilt fruiting vine above a pink ground - all saucers have small issues, including regilding of chips to rim edges, one of the teacups is badly cracked.

Gadrooned rim saucer painted with butterfly and flowers - cracked.

Maroon ground cup gilt with fruiting vine - chip to rim.

Remaining items in the lot are in good condition overall with minor typical wear commensurate with age and handling, no significant damage or restoration.
