A group of Barr, Flight & Barr Worcester wares, early 19th century, painted and gilt in chinoiserie style with birds in branches by prunus blossom beside a large pink tree trunk, comprising a pair of square dishes with shaped rims, length 23cm, a pair of saucer dishes, 20cm diameter, slop bowl, 17cm diameter, jug, two teacups with ring handles and two saucers, impressed and printed marks to bases (minor faults). Provenance: The Flight Collection.

Condition Report

One saucer with faint starcrack. Minor firing crack to base interior of slop bowl.

Otherwise each item in the lot is in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. There is minor typical wear/light surface scratches commensurate with age and handling, but nothing untoward.
