### Condition Report

Teapot - starcrack to base, professionally restored cover.

Single handled circular dish - tiny spot of professional restoration to rim edge of handle.

Otherwise items in the lot are in good condition overall with no significant damage or restoration but some typical rubbing/wear primarily to the gilt rims.
