A pair of Coalport two-handled vases and covers, early 20th century, painted with opposing mountainous landscape views within gilt framing against gilt overlaid cobalt blue ground bodies, flanked by gilt ram's head handles, the domed covers with gilt finials, green printed and red painted factory marks to bases, height 31cm, together with a similarly decorated smaller pair of Coalport two-handled vases, height 20cm, another pair of Coalport vases and covers painted by Howard, signed, with flowers, height 18cm, and a pair of Royal Doulton two-handled vases and covers painted by Wood, signed, with flowers, height 17cm (faults and repairs throughout).

Condition Report

Largest pair Coalport vases - both with overall fine crazing to the glaze, one with glued knop on cover.

Smaller pair Coalport two-handled vases - one with extensively restored foot, other with similar restoration to neck and upper handle terminals.

Pair Coalport painted by Howard - both with overall fine crazing to glaze, one with indistinct vertical haircrack to neck rim running behind one upper handle terminal, one cover extensively restored, other with glued knop.

Pair Doulton vases - one with extensively restored body, other ok with fine crazing to the glaze overall.
