A rare A.G. Hopkins Lambeth Pottery stoneware owl with removable head cover, dated 1928, in the style of a Martin Brothers Wally Bird, with pale blue glazed wings and head, the white chest feathers with pinkish red touches, its eyes looking to the right, one partially closed, incised marks to top of main body, height 29.5cm (minor restoration).

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

The left ear has a glued repair and some filled, repainted restoration to the front side with a subsequent small flake missing from this filled repair.

The pupil of the right eye has a filled chip to its top edge, possibly since manufacture.

There is a minor and indistinct flat chip to the inner edge of the main body which the head slots into - so not visible when the head is in place.

Otherwise the owl is in good condition overall.
