A Flight, Barr & Barr Worcester Japan pattern slop bowl, early 19th century, painted and gilt with a chinoiserie pattern with a pagoda, fretwork fence, flowers and a bird perched amidst branches, impressed mark to base, diameter 17.5cm, together with an unusual cream jug, probably Worcester, painted and gilt with a winged mythical beast opposing a dragon, unmarked, height 11cm, and two other cream jugs (minor faults). Provenance: The Flight Collection.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

Slop bowl - some regilding to rim, light scratches to base interior and some scratches to exterior.

Jug with mythical beast and dragon - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Imari jug - pattern No. 136, small chip to spout, otherwise ok.

Blue leaves on apricot ground jug - rubbing to gilding of handle and rim, otherwise in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration.
