### LOT 1405

Two Flight, Barr & Barr Worcester pin trays, early 19th century, both of rectangular shape with gilt gadrooned rim, the first painted with a titled view 'Tomb of Napoleon, St. Helena' within a gilt frame and pale blue ground, flanked by gilt handles with foliate terminals, the rim underside with a gilt cracked ice pattern, length 13.5cm, the second painted with a Pyne style peasant figure against a cream ground cornered with butterflies, overhead gilt handle, length 12cm, puce and black painted marks to bases, and a small Barr Worcester pin tray painted with flowers, length 9cm (faults and restoration). Provenance: The Flight Collection.

### Condition Report

Tomb of Napoleon - some scratches to painted view and light rubbing to gilding overall, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Other pin tray with handle - handle restored back into position at terminals, minor professional restoration to footrim and a few absolutely tiny nicks to rim edge with professional restoration.

Pin tray with flowers - 2 small chips and a nick to rim edge which has rubbed gilding, surface scratches.
