A Seiko Bell-Matic stainless steel gentleman's bracelet wristwatch, Ref. 4006-6040, circa August 1973, with signed and jewelled 4006A caliber automatic movement, the signed champagne tinted dial with baton hour markers, day and date aperture and rotating bezel with alarm indicator, the signed case back detailed '4006-6040' and numbered '380122', the tapered link bracelet with signed foldover clasp, case diameter 3.9cm.

Condition Report

1027. The watch is in generally good condition, with typical surface scratches and wear to case, crystal and bracelet. Clasp with small dent, but in working order. No significant damage or repairs. Dial in good clean condition.

The automatic movement winds and is currently working but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Day rolls over as it should and button adjusts date correctly.

Inner bezel rotates via crown and adjusts smoothly via the crown/winder.

Unfortunately the alarm is not sounding/working.

Bracelet at present setting approx 16-16.5cm.

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
