### LOT 1439

A group of Worcester Dragons In Compartments pattern wares, late 18th/early 19th century, painted and gilt with mythical beasts and precious objects, comprising a drum shaped inkwell with ring handle, height 6.5cm, three plates, 23cm diameter, 21.8cm diameter and 22cm diameter, slop bowl, 16cm diameter, fluted teacup and saucer, two coffee cans and one saucer, some impressed marks (faults and restoration). Provenance: The Flight Collection.

### Condition Report

Inkwell - missing well and cover, one pen wipe section heavily restored some time ago so it is discoloured and peeling, overall quite rubbed, starcrack to base interior of main well area, both exterior pen holders with vertical cracks.

Scalloped rim plate - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Notched rim plate - heavily restored rim, quite worn.

Circular plate - badly cracked, rubbed/worn.

Slop bowl - indistinct vertical haircrack to rim, otherwise ok.

Plain rimmed saucer restored, other saucer ok.

Cups - generally in good condition.
