Three Flight, Barr & Barr Worcester sauce tureens and covers, early 19th century, each of circular bulbous shape, the first painted and gilt with a chinoiserie pink pavilion surrounded by birds in branches and flowers, flanked by scroll handles above gilt acanthus leaf moulding, the other two painted and gilt in Japan colours with flowers and foliage, impressed marks to bases, each 17cm high (faults and restoration).

Condition Report

Pink Pavillion - patches of professional restoration to top rim edge, finial of cover with small chip.

Japan colours with gilt gadrooned rim - riveted repair to knob of cover and small chip to inner flange of cover, otherwise ok.

Mainly white ground with Japan flowers - one handle restored, minor associated restoration to rim which also has a small chip, cover extensively restored.
