A Jaeger-LeCoultre Atmos mantel timepiece, Ref. 528-6, the signed perpetual gilt brass movement numbered '366217', the square white chapter ring with gilt Arabic numeral and arrowhead hour markers, the lacquered brass and glazed case with canted corners, plinth base and bracket feet, height 23.3cm, width 20.8cm.

Condition Report

1190. The Atmos timepiece is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs.

Brass case with typical light surface scratches and wear. Little dusty and dirty.

The removeable front glass panel has a chip to the bottom right corner which can be seen in the images on our website, and a much smaller chip to the other bottom corner which is hidden by the case when in place.

Otherwise all other glass panels in good condition.

Dial in good clean condition.

When unlocked, the movement works and it is keeping good time, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

There is no box or paperwork present.

The serial number would suggest it is a 1970s model and we would think mid-1970s.
