A late 19th century French gilt lacquered brass carriage clock by Margaine of Paris, the eight day movement striking hours and half hours and repeating on a gong, the backplate with stamped maker's mark and numbered '11401', the white enameled dial detailed 'T. Martin & Co 151 Regent St, London... Paris', the glazed case with fluted swing handle and corner columns, height 18.3cm, with winding key.
