### LOT 1805

A Gallé cameo glass atomiser, early 20th century, the frosted cylindrical body overlaid in yellow and amber and carved with nasturtium flowers and leaves, carved cameo signature to side, the gilt metal mounts marked 'LE PARISIEN', overall height 12cm (tiny chip to foot of glass, atomiser not working), together with a small Louis Comfort Tiffany Favrile glass bowl, height 3cm, and a Weis cameo glass vase, height 10.3cm (fault to rim).

Estimate: £80 - £120

### Condition Report

Galle atomiser - atomiser mechanism not working properly, probably has some elements missing, and is detached from the glass body. The metal mounts have wear. There is a tiny chip to the base edge of the glass body, otherwise the glass is in good condition overall.

Tiffany - in good condition overall with light typical surface wear.

Weis - indistinct internal crack to neck rim, quite tricky to see until you position the vase correctly, some very minor nibbles to neck rim.
