A late 19th century French walnut and gilt metal mounted fountain clock, the eight day movement with platform escapement, the backplate stamped 'E.G.L.', the white enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals and detailed 'H.W. Bedford & Compy LD 105, Regent Street London', the case with turned finials above turned and fluted columns, the front with gilt metal lion mask issuing a spiralled glass 'water' rod above a gilt metal scallop shell, on a moulded plinth base and bracket feet, height 43.5cm.

Condition Report

1189. The clock is in generally good cosmetic condition with typical light surface scratches, scuffs and wear to case, but no significant damage or repairs. Dial in good clean condition.

The movement winds smoothly and is currently running but stops sporadically and it does not fully wind as it 'slips' as the spring tightens.

The automation glass rod movement winds smoothly and is currently working well, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.
