A late 19th century inlaid walnut wall clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the painted dial inscribed 'H. Samuel Manchester', the case with carved and pierced foliate surmount above inlaid decoration and glazed door, height 89cm, with pendulum.

Estimate: £50 - £70

Condition Report

1177. The clock is in good cosmetic condition except for the top of the carved crest surmount having broken off, so would need regluing. Otherwise just typical light surface scratches, scuffs and wear.

Dial in generally good order.

The going train winds smoothly but only runs for a couple of minutes before stopping.

The striking train does not wind and striking mechanism does not work.
