A 19th century oak and mahogany crossbanded longcase clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the 13-inch painted breakarch dial with black Roman hour numerals, subsidiary seconds and date aperture, the hood with swan neck pediment, glazed door and turned columns, the crossbanded trunk door above a plain base and bracket feet, height 217cm (glass broken), with pendulum and two weights.

Estimate: £50 - £100

Condition Report

1207. The case will need some attention. Glass to hood is broken, some splits to veneers, trunk door slightly warped, we have the case key but it does not lock properly. Base panel with significant vertical splits. Dial in generally good order with some typical wear and minor paint chips to edges. We have a winder which winds the movement smoothly, but it is not currently running.
