A Victorian silver cased keywind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch with unsigned gilt fusee movement, the white enamelled dial later printed with a head and shoulders portrait of Admiral Nelson, Chester 1860, case diameter 5.2cm.

Condition Report

1087. The watch is in generally good condition. Typical surface scratches and wear, the back of the case with more pronounced wear to the engraving. Front hinged door is good and closes tightly. Back hinge is a little wobbly but closes tightly.

Enamel dial is later/modern printed with Nelson and is otherwise in good condition.

Movement winds smoothly and it is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.
