A small collection of Roman and other ancient silver and bronze copper coinage, including a Roman Republic denarius, Roma type, a Philip I (The Arab) antoninianus, circa 244 AD, reverse with Roma seated left, holding Victory and sceptre, and a Maxentius follis, reverse with Roma seated within temple.

Condition Report

3077. Roman Republic denarius - good/fair, irregular flan, even wear, dark patina.

Roman antoninianus - good/fine, reverse strike weak as fairly common for this issue, toned.

Copper alloy coinage only - fair/good throughout, some corrosion in places, one or two better.

Maxentius follis - good/fine, cleaned in the past, now toned.
