An Eberhard & Co Extra-Fort Chronograph stainless steel gentleman's bracelet wristwatch, Ref. 31951, the signed silvered dial with baton hour markers, two subsidiary dials, date aperture and centre stop seconds, the signed case back numbered '31951' above '5-ATM' and '1-4229', the link bracelet with signed foldover clasp, case diameter 3.9cm, with Eberhard & Co rectangular box.

Condition Report

1053. Typical light surface scratches and wear to case, bracelet and crystal/glass. Dial in good clean condition. Clasp in good working order. Bracelet a little dirty so would benefit from a clean.

Crown screws down tightly onto the case.

The movement winds and adjusts smoothly, date rolls over as it should, and it is currently running but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

The date does not roll over as it should from the crown. The chrono features top button works with starting and stopping the second hand, but the lower button appears jammed and so does not work.

Wood box is ok but interior is badly deteriorated.

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
