A Victorian silver pair cased keywind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch, the gilt fusee movement with verge escapement and pierced and engraved foliate scroll balance cock, the backplate detailed 'Jno Pike Node Hill Newport 29060', the white enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals, the inner and outer cases London 1850, outer case diameter 5.5cm, together with a similar matched silver pair cased gentleman's pocket watch, the gilt fusee movement with verge escapement and pierced and engraved balance cock, the backplate detailed 'Thos Lettin London 1805', inner case London 1805, outer case London 1827, outer case diameter 5.2cm, with two watch keys.
