A George V silver mounted desk clock, barometer and mercury thermometer, the central thermometer flanked by a Goliath pocket barometer and a Goliath eight day pocket watch, each with white enamel dials and inscribed 'Mappin & Webb Ltd', the case of shaped rectangular form, monogram and date engraved, with an easel back, Birmingham 1911 by Mappin & Webb Ltd, height 13.5cm, length 21.5cm.

Condition Report

315. Generally good condition. The silver mount to case with typical light surface scratches and wear, and a small dent to top right corner and to top centre, some minor dents around apertures. Good clear hallmarks. The rest of the case is structurally ok, but a bit tatty with some leather loss and wear to back, but hinge is good. The watch winds and adjusts smoothly but only runs for a few seconds so may require a service to return to full working order. Dial in good order. Case good with typical wear.

Barometer case with typical light surface scratches and wear. Dial ok and it is currently in working order, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability.

Thermometer tube is intact and is working, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability. Brass backplate a little dirty and worn.
