A Chinese blue and white porcelain ginger jar and cover, mark of Qianlong but late 19th century, the ovoid body painted with a continuous band of two dragons chasing flaming pearls amidst clouds and vapours, the shoulder with the eight Buddhist emblems, underglaze blue pseudo seal mark to base, height 24.8cm (neck damaged), with a wood stand.

Condition Report

1075. Approximately half of the rim is broken and missing and another piece of rim re-glued. Otherwise, the body of the jar is in good condition with no cracks or repairs, and well painted decoration. Cover in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs.
