340. The mustard is in generally good condition. Typical light surface scratches and some wear to surface. Hinge is a little wobbly, but otherwise cover in good order. Good clear hallmarks t body and cover interior. Total weight including glass liner and spoon is 171g (the glass liner is set inside and we are unable to remove it). Spoon in good condition.
