LOT 590

A set of three late Victorian silver, gold set and diamond starburst brooches, each mounted with cushion shaped and rose cut diamonds, comprising one large and two smaller examples, unmarked, total weight 21.2g, total diamond weight approx 7.00-8.00ct, width of largest brooch 4.7cm, with the original fitted case.

Estimate: £2,000 - £3,000

Condition Report

590. The gold has tested at approx. 7ct gold.

One small brooch has had a solder repair to its removeable fitting. This fitting is now lacking its screw and cannot be removed. This brooch has a later safety chain attached.

The largest starburst looks to have had a repair to its hook fitting at the back.

Measurements of large star approx. 4.5cm x 4.3cm. Measurements of smaller star approx. 2.7cm x 2.5cm.

The diamonds have a variety of shapes and cuts, one or two possibly could have been replaced but it does not look obviously the case. One or two diamonds chipped. Diamond grading (estimates and for guidance only) – average clarity SI, average colour I/J.

The box does not open that easily and has noticeable wear.
