### LOT 331

A small group of silver, comprising an Old English pattern dessert spoon, London 1811, two Fiddle pattern teaspoons, London 1851, a set of seven coffee spoons, each with a scallop shell bowl (two damaged), total weight 147g, and three Chinese silver teaspoons, each with a three-character terminal, weight 34.3g, together with a pair of plated sugar tongs.

Estimate: £60 - £80

### Condition Report

331. All Fiddle pattern spoons with wear and scratches.

Five scallop salt spoons – generally ok with typical surface wear and scratches. Stems slightly misshapen.

Two salt spoons are broken.

Three Chinese spoons in generally good order with no significant damage or repairs. Typical surface scratches and wear.
