Condition Report

395. The clock is in generally good condition, small crack to one of the front feet, which has then had a small lead repair. Otherwise no other significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear. Good clear hallmarks. No engraving or inscriptions.

The movement winds smoothly, it is currently running and the strike mechanism is also working as it should, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Dial in generally good condition but lettering is worn.
