### LOT 1472

A Wedgwood Fairyland lustre octagonal bowl, circa 1920, designed by Daisy Makeig-Jones, the interior decorated with the Woodland Elves VIII Boxing Match pattern, the exterior with the Castle on a Road pattern within gilt cobble frame borders, gilt printed Portland Vase mark to base and painted pattern No. Z5125, diameter 27cm.

### Condition Report

The bowl is in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. It 'rings' nicely when tapped to the side.

The gilding remains good with no real signs of wear or rubbing, similarly the enamels.

There are some surface scratches to the base interior, nothing too terrible and only really noticeable in the right light.

There are some typical minor and insignificant discrepancies to the decoration as a result of the manufacturing process, e.g., some minor running/blurring of the colours.

One of the exterior faces/sides of the bowl has an approximate 2cm long horizontal scratch near the rim just below the cobble border, nothing terrible.
