### LOT 1469

A Wedgwood Coral and Bronze Fairyland lustre Imperial circular bowl, circa 1925, designed by Daisy Makeig-Jones, decorated in the Willow pattern, the mother-of-pearl lustre interior with a band of magpies and masks around a central base checker rosette, gold printed Portland Vase mark to base underside and painted pattern No. Z5349, diameter 23.3cm.

Estimate: £200 - £300

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### Condition Report

The bowl is in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. It 'rings' nicely when tapped to the side.

The gilding remains good with no real signs of wear or rubbing. There are some minor and insignificant losses to the coral enamel, e.g., to some of the dots on the exterior of the footrim.

There are some typical light surface scratches to the base interior and the exterior of the bowl has some scratches/digs resulting in the white body showing through – these aren't terrible and few and far between.

There is a stray tiny blob of coral enamel to the top edge of the rim interior – a manufacturing issue, not damage.

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
