### LOT 1422

A mixed group of pottery and porcelain, mostly 19th century, including a blue printed soup tureen, cover and stand with a matched ladle, a Derby scent bottle and stopper painted with a bird panel against a cobalt blue ground, height 11cm, a Carlton Ware Chinaland pattern sugar bowl, diameter 10.5cm, a Royal Worcester blush ivory circular patch box and cover, two Japanese Imari scalloped rim dishes, diameter 22cm, two Royal Doulton blue printed series ware plates, a Wild Rose blue printed oval platter, length 40.5cm, and some cabinet cups and saucers including Davenport and Ridgway (faults and repairs).

### Condition Report

Tureen - cover with haircracks and small nicks to ladle notch, hairline across one handle of main body, ladle ok, stand crazed with light staining, scratches, hairline and small chip to rim underside.

Derby scent bottle - small chip and nick to underside rim edge of cover, main body with fine crazing and some wear to the gilding overall, on the rim and cover especially.

Carlton Ware sugar bowl - light wear, generally ok.

Worcester patch box - cover restored.

Wild Rose platter - crazed but ok.

Pair Japanese dishes - ok.

2 Royal Doulton plates - crazed but ok.

Jug - ok.

Nodding head figure - body with glued repairs.

Pair diamond shaped dishes - both crazed with light staining, one with riveted repairs, other with chipped footrim.

Small teacup with pink roses - hairlines and crazing.

Miniature Imari cup and saucer - footrim of cup restored.

Pale blue ground teacup and saucer with high loop handle - cup ok, saucer heavily crazed with wear to gilt well.

Cobalt blue ground cup and saucer - Grainger - good condition.

Davenport cup and saucer - cup cracked.

Ridgway cup and saucer - ok.
