Four pieces of John Dunn studio pottery, comprising two circular chargers, both covered in an iridized raku glaze, one of pale orange tint, diameter 36cm, the other of pale lemon tint, diameter 33.8cm, a dished rectangular platter with pale blue crystalline glaze to the surface and painted geometric pattern to the underside, length 33cm, and a circular bowl covered in an orange iridized raku glaze, diameter 29cm, painted marks to bases.

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

33.8cm circular dish has pinhead sized glaze flake to black rim edge, hardly noticeable apart from on close inspection, otherwise all circular pieces in good condition with no damage or repairs.

The blue rectangular dish has some minor glaze scuffs to the black edge and some 'scratch' like lines to the blue glaze near the rim, only noticeable on close inspection and would appear to be a manufacturing issue.
