### LOT 1512

A Berlin porcelain Bellarmine style jug, late 19th/early 20th century, painted with a circular panel depicting peasant figures dancing, within a gilt frame, against a brown glazed ground relief moulded with fruiting vine and geometric motifs beneath a mask to the spout, underglaze blue sceptre mark to base and indistinct impressed numerals, height 31cm.

Estimate: £200 - £300

### Condition Report

In good condition overall with no chips or restoration.

There is an approximate 4cm long horizontal firing crack to the inside of the neck, not visible to the exterior.

The gilding is typically rubbed, particularly noticeable on the top rim edge but to the body overall commensurate with normal handling and age.
