### LOT 1427

A studio pottery bowl, probably Geoffrey Doonan, of egg shape, the brown exterior with deep and shallow haphazard sgraffito scratches, the off centre aperture revealing a speckled off white glazed interior, black painted mark 'DOONAN' to base, length 44cm (faults).

Estimate: £50 - £80

### Condition Report

There are two almost parallel horizontal haircracks running approximately two thirds of the way around the bowl interior, through and from firing cracks, in some areas these are visible to the bowl exterior but mainly visible to the interior. In addition there is a largish firing crack to the exterior of the body on the widest part where the potter has also filled a small area during manufacture.

Overall the rough finish has some small nicks/chips to the edges only really noticeable on closer inspection.
