Two pieces of Royal Worcester painted with still life fruit studies, comprising a cabinet cup with gilt exterior, dated 1926, signed Everett, and a matched saucer, dated 1924, indistinctly signed, diameter of saucer 10cm, and a Royal Worcester rectangular dish with gilt gadrooned rim, dated 1926, signed Townsend, length 17.5cm.

Estimate: £150 - £200

Condition Report

Saucer - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. The gilt well has typical surface wear/scratches where the cup sits, a few very minor and inconsequential scratches to the painted ground. No crazing.

Cup - overall crazing to the glaze, 2 tiny spots of wear to the gilt handle, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Dish - No crazing, a few tiny scratches and light wear but otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
