Condition Report

Jennifer - overall fine crazing to the glaze, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

A Victorian Lady - overall fine crazing to the glaze and some longer craze lines visible through skirts, base and bare skin. One of the longer craze lines to the left wrist could be described as a hairline.

Sweet Anne - overall fine crazing to the glaze, small area of professional restoration to very front edge of skirt hem on left side of figure, approx 2cm long by 0.5cm wide.

Bridget - 3 minuscule nicks to side edge of black shoe just poking out from beneath skirts, otherwise ok.

Lady Charmian - chipping to petals of rose she's holding in right hand, otherwise ok.

Remaining items in the lot are in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
