A Worcester trio, circa 1780, painted in blue and gilt with floral sprays, comprising teacup, coffee cup and saucer, blue painted open crescent mark to bases, together with a small group of blush ivory Royal Worcester, comprising three flatback jugs, a tusk jug, height 19cm, and a pair of two-handled vases, height 16cm, and a Royal Worcester two-handled vase and cover painted with pink roses, height 19cm (faults).

Estimate: £150 - £200

Condition Report

Trio - saucer has haircrack to well, teacup has wear to base gilt interior, coffee cup has minute nick to gilt rim and wear to gilt line around top of foot.

Flatback jugs - ivory ground example with faint starcrack to spout, two blush ivory examples in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Tusk Jug - light wear/rubbing to gilding, otherwise ok.

Pair - possibly missing covers, one with area of re-gilding to foot, other with one restored handle.

Vase painted with roses - cover missing finial, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
