A Minton majolica shell ewer, modelled by Hugues Protât, dated 1867, shape No. 1136, the scallop shell body with fish scale ground, surmounted by a twin tailed mermaid beneath the spout and a similar young merman beneath the handle, raised on a shell moulded spreading circular foot, impressed factory marks to base and Protât monogram to base of handle, height 38cm (repair to spout).

## Condition Report

Overall typical fine crazing to the glaze.

The end of the spout has a visible glued repair - no pieces would appear to be missing. Please see the images on our website.

There is a very minor narrow glaze nick to the edge of the handle approx 0.5cm long.
