Two small Wemyss pottery pigs, early 20th century, the first a money box sponged with black markings, impressed mark to base, the second painted with thistles, green painted mark to base, both 15cm long (faults and restoration).

### Condition Report

Black and white pig - heavily crazed overall, discoloured restoration to left ear and around money slot, minor glaze loss to edge of right ear.

Thistles pig - heavily crazed with some staining, horizontal hairline running around body of pig, fritting to edges of ears and snout, right foot made up.
