A large pair of Doulton Burslem pottery vases, late 19th century, decorated in blue and gilt with poppy like flowers against a cream ground, the waisted necks and circular feet cobalt blue glazed, impressed and blue printed marks to bases, height 44cm.

Condition Report

Both vases are in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

There is typical light rubbing/wear to the gilding and light surface scratches commensurate with age and handling but nothing untoward.

Both have typical fine crazing to the glaze.
