### LOT 1404

A Mintons Balmoral pattern dinner plate, dated 1892, painted to the rim with a crown enclosed within a pink flowered wreath frame tied with a blue ribbon, opposing an entwined gilt 'VA' monogram standing for Queen Victoria and Prince Albert, with the same pink flowered wreath frame, the rim with gilt dentil detail, impressed marks to base with puce printed retailer's stamp for Mortlock, Regent St., diameter 26cm.

Estimate: £40 - £60

### Condition Report

In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

A few typical light surface scratches commensurate with age and handling, but nothing untoward and the enamels and gilding remain good with no signs of wear.

There is a deeper scratch approximately 5cm long to the underside of the cavetto - only noticeable when inverted and on close inspection.
