A mid to late 19th century United States Colt police issue .36 five-shot percussion revolver, serial number 3731, with round barrel, barrel length 14cm, detailed 'Address Col Saml. Colt New-York U.S. America', nipple foresight, fluted cylinder, marked 'Pat. Sept. 10th 1853', the frame marked 'Colts patent', brass trigger guard, wood plate grips and hinged-action rammer, matching serial numbers throughout.

3501. Gun does not look to be altered. Action works nice and tight, we cannot give an opinion on barrel interior. Gun generally looks honest throughout with nice patination. Some minor bruises to steel work and wooden grip. Slither of wood lacking where grip plate meets the brass handle spine.
