A Jaeger-LeCoultre Atmos mantel timepiece, Ref. 528-8, the signed perpetual gilt brass movement numbered '260565', the signed square white chapter ring with gilt Arabic numeral and arrowhead hour markers, the lacquered brass and glazed case with canted corners, plinth base and bracket feet, height 23.5cm, width 21cm, with original fitted case.

Condition Report

1145. The case is in generally good cosmetic condition. Typical light surface scratches and wear, but no significant damage or repairs.

Dial generally ok but with some minor dirt spots and light scratches and wear.

Sprung front glass panel good and other glass panels appear to be in good order.

Movement locking mechanism appears to work as it should, but unfortunately it is not currently running, so would require attention.

Outer case in generally good order, hinges are good. Typical light scratches and scuffs.
