A Jaeger-LeCoultre Atmos mantel timepiece, Ref. 526-5, the signed perpetual gilt brass movement numbered '393246', the white circular chapter ring with gilt Arabic numeral and arrowhead hour markers, the lacquered brass and glazed case with canted corners, plinth base and bracket feet, height 22.2cm, width 17.9cm, with original fitted case, instruction booklet, brochure booklet and strap.

Condition Report

1160. Generally good condition, no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear.

Hinge door opens smoothly and all glass panels appear to be in good condition.

Dial in good clean condition. Movement lock in good working order.

The movement is working and over a 3 hour test period is keeping good accurate time, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Outer case generally ok, but with typical scuffs and wear. Both hinged front doors in working order and close well, Some rusting to hinges and clasps on front.
