A Universal Genève Polerouter Automatic 18K circular cased gentleman's wristwatch with signed and jewelled movement, the signed gilt dial with baton hour markers, the case back detailed '10376-24' above '2141927', case diameter 3.3cm, on a gold tapered meshlink bracelet with foldover clasp, detailed '18ct', total weight 74.9g, case diameter 3.4cm, total length 21cm.

1035. The watch appears to be in generally good clean condition. The automatic movement winds and adjust smoothly and it is currently working, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Dial in good clean condition, some very minor pitting visible under x10 magnification, but no significant damage or scratches. The glass/crystal is scratched which include the scratches you can see at 5 o'clock in the online images.

Case exterior with typical light scratches and wear, but no significant damage.

Bracelet generally good, but with typical misshaping. The clasp in working order, has engraved initials.

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
