An Omega 9ct gold circular cased gentleman's wristwatch, circa 1930, the signed and jewelled manual wind movement numbered '8474797', the signed white enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals and subsidiary seconds, Birmingham 1936, case diameter 3.1cm, on a brown leather strap, together with an Omega gilt metal cushion cased gentleman's wristwatch, circa 1935, the signed and jewelled movement numbered '8811429', the signed white enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals and subsidiary seconds, the case back interior numbered '280935' above '39', case width 3cm, on a tan leather strap.

1036. Omega circular case - generally good cosmetic condition with typical surface scratches and wear. Dial is good. Hinged back is good. Adjusts smoothly but does not run at present.

Omega cushion case - generally good condition. Typical surface scratches and wear to the gilt metal plating on the case around the edges and corners. Dial in good order. Winds and adjusts smoothly and is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Over a 2 hour test period, the watch kept good time.
