A Longines 18K gold circular cased gentleman's wristwatch, circa 1954, the signed and jewelled 27M caliber manual wind movement numbered '9613449', the signed silvered dial with Arabic numeral and arrowhead shaped hour markers and subsidiary seconds, the signed case back detailed '18K 0.750' and numbered '6050.13' above '49', case diameter 3.4cm, on a brown leather strap, with Longines brown leather rectangular case.

Condition Report

1057. The watch is in generally good condition. Typical light surface scratches and wear to case, but no significant damage or repairs. Glass/crystal is scratched. Dial with some slight pitting visible under x10 magnification, as well as some dirt specks. There is also a very small length of thread stuck between the dial and glass.

The movement winds and adjust smoothly and is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Over a 2 hour test period, the watch kept good time.
